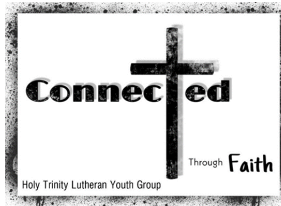

Changes to LLL Accounts

LLL Accounts are transitioning to a different model. In the future most of us will be able to access two different kinds of accounts.

1. Notice of Withdrawal Facility. Funds may be withdrawn from this facility with 31 days written notice. Current interest rate is 3.70%.
2. Term Investment Facility. This is an ordinary term investment with a 31 day, 6 or 12 month term. No fees or charges. Up to 4.85% interest.

The instant access or pay into accounts other than one of the same name in a different bank will no longer be offered. Other banking type services will not be offered. The LLL is hoping to have all accounts transitioned to the new model by the end of June. For information or help ring them on 1800 556 457.
